### 1. The International Whistling Seminars

### 2. Whistling Competition: May 27-29

Application Fee: RMB 500.00 (for Adults and Seniors only; Teenagers and Children are free)

Examples are: mime, acting, singing, instrumentation, improvisation, comedy, dance, and unique vocal sounds such as hand-whistling and bird calls). Separate Championships are named for allied Arts.
